He was best known for his swashbuckling roles in silent films such as *The Thief of Baghdad*, *Robin Hood*, and *The Mark of Zorro*. His book, *Laugh and Live*, is a book about positive virtues and advice for leading a good, healthy, and successful life. An advisory about this book is in order. Published in 1917, it was written at a time when “men went to work, women kept house, and supported their man,” Some of the writing and references are old-fashioned by today’s standards.
